Job Title: L. A. County Stage Intern

The Lancaster Performing Arts Center (LPAC) is located in the Antelope Valley, and is owned and operated by the City of Lancaster. LPAC consists of a 758 seat main stage proscenium theatre and the 110 seat J. P. Eliopoulos Family Theatre. LPAC presents over 200 performances annually of musicals, comedy, Country, Bluegrass, Celtic, Ballet, Modern dance, Symphony, Choir, produces an in-house production in December and works outdoor events April through July.

The Position: Under the supervision of the Technical Director or Assistant Technical Director, the Stage Intern duties include: assisting the Directors with the pre-planning, stage management requirements and construction scheduling for the December in-house production. This position will also offer the intern opportunities for working along side house crew in the hang and focus of the house lighting systems, study of basic lighting design and color theory, theatrical rigging and operation of single purchase counterweight system, sound reinforcement techniques, stage management functions, follow spot training, running crew experience, stage carpentry and other projects as assigned.

Qualifications: Applicants should be: a current undergraduate student with at least one semester of college by June, 2008 who will not graduate before December, 2008 and either a resident of, or attending college in, L. A. County; reliable and responsible; able to work without immediate supervision and to plan, organize and implement tasks as assigned; possess a valid California driver's license. Candidates who have taken a college level stage craft, lighting or sound class, or have equal experience, are preferred, but not necessary.

Abilities and Knowledge: Applicants must be able to follow written and oral instructions; be flexible working with people of varying degrees of theatrical knowledge and with the public; be available to work some evenings, weekends, and holidays. The selected candidate is expected to attend required meetings and field trips presented by the L. A. County Arts Commission.

Salary: \$350/week for a total of ten weeks; 40 hours per week.
