

## **AUDITION NOTICE**

Lancaster Performing Arts Center Missoula Children's Theatre's Rumpelstiltskin

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The audition for the Missoula Children's Theatre production, *Rumpelstiltskin* will be held Monday, March 13, 2023 at the Lancaster Performing Arts Center (LPAC). There are roles for students Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Approximately 50-60 local students will be cast to appear in the show. There is no guarantee that everyone who auditions will be cast in the play. Children auditioning and their accompanying chaperone (one per child) should arrive at the LPAC's front entrance by 2:45 p.m. and plan to stay until 5:30 p.m. Select cast members (dependent on role) will be asked to stay for a rehearsal immediately following the audition, which will end at approximately 8:00 PM.

This is a group audition—**no advance preparation is necessary**, but a smile never hurts. Students should just be ready to come and have a good time!

Rehearsals will be conducted Tuesday through Thursday, March 14 - 16 at LPAC with performances on Friday, March 17, 2023. Although not all cast members will be needed at every session, those auditioning must have a clear schedule for the entire week and if selected, be able to attend all rehearsals required for their role and be available for all scheduled performances. A detailed rehearsal schedule will be distributed at the conclusion of the audition. Cast members scheduled for all rehearsal sessions will be asked to bring a sack lunch, dinner or snack to be eaten during the 15-minute break between sessions.

- Rehearsals are closed; the facility will not be open to parents, siblings, etc. during rehearsal times.
- Children must be checked in with staff prior to rehearsals and performances each day.
- Children must be picked up by an authorized parent or guardian (bring ID) immediately after rehearsals and performances each day.

The performances will be held at LPAC on Friday, March 17 at 10 AM (Arts for Youth school show) and 7 PM (public show).

This coming year more than 65,000 cast members across the globe will take to the stage to the delight and applause of their families, friends, community, neighbors and teachers!
